





BACK TO THE BEGINNING

That settles it!*


Your word is truth. John 17:17 (ESV)




God loves us and wants us to spend forever in heaven with him!


★ Trace the path of the thrill ride through history that shows how he made a way for us to live with him forever!





GO! AND **DO!** →




1 Jump up and scrunch down. Tell someone about the highs and lows of time you heard about today.

GO! AND **DO!** →

1 Act out Adam naming the birds.

2 Fly around like a bird. Tell someone about how God made birds.


3 Look out the window. Do you see a bird? Say, “Thank you, God, for birds!”

4 Make up a song with today’s Bible verse.

Behold, Behemoth.

Job 40:15 (ESV)

★ Practice the verse several times, moving around like the giant behemoth dinosaur as you say it.



GO! AND **DO!** →

1 Walk around like a dinosaur and tell someone that God made the dinosaurs!

2 Make a picture showing behemoth or leviathan. (Behemoth is thought to be a sauropod dinosaur.)

3 Make up a song with today's memory verse.

4 See how many things you can name that God created! Say, "Isn't God incredible?!"
